DEFINATION:

The Scholarship Committee of the Gainesboro First United Methodist Church will make awards each year. This fund is held and governed by the Tennessee – Western Kentucky Conference. Successful applicants may apply each succeeding year for scholarships.

SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS:

The scholarship monies will be sent to the institution for credit toward tuition, supplies, books, institution fees and for dormitory charges on campus. No monies will be given to the individual.

SCHOLARSHIP RECEIPIENT QUALIFICATIONS:

The scholarship recipients will be chosen from candidates who have made suitable application and possess certain qualifications and attributes. It is generally intended that these scholarships be granted to those in Jackson County who demonstrate their desire to improve or expand their education.

The qualifications for recipients of scholarship funds are:

- 1.) They must be a resident of Jackson County since January 1st of the year of the scholarship fund.
- 2.) They must have graduated from high school or satisfactorily completed the requirements for a GED high school equivalency.
- 3.) They must show they have applied and have been accepted at:
 - A.) An accredited university or college.
 - B.) An accredited vocational school
 - C.) An accredited trade school.
- 4.) They must have submitted a scholarship application to the Gainesboro First UMC by May 1, 2023.
- 5.) They must show financial need.
- 6.) They must show scholastic aptitude though scholastic achievement may be assigned a lesser role.
- 7.) They must have good moral character.
- 8.) They must be willing to be interviewed by local selection committee.
- 9.) Age will no criterion.
- 10.) The recipient will be allowed to receive other additional scholarships from other sources.
- 11.) The recipient is not required to be a member of the local United Methodist Church.
- 12.) A requirement for this scholarship is that you attend the presentation on May 21, 2023 at the First UMC, Gainesboro. A luncheon for you and your family will follow the presentation.

A selection of recipients will be made as soon as possible after the interview process is complete.
